Where is the Conference ?

Shipham Village Hall. BS25 1SG.

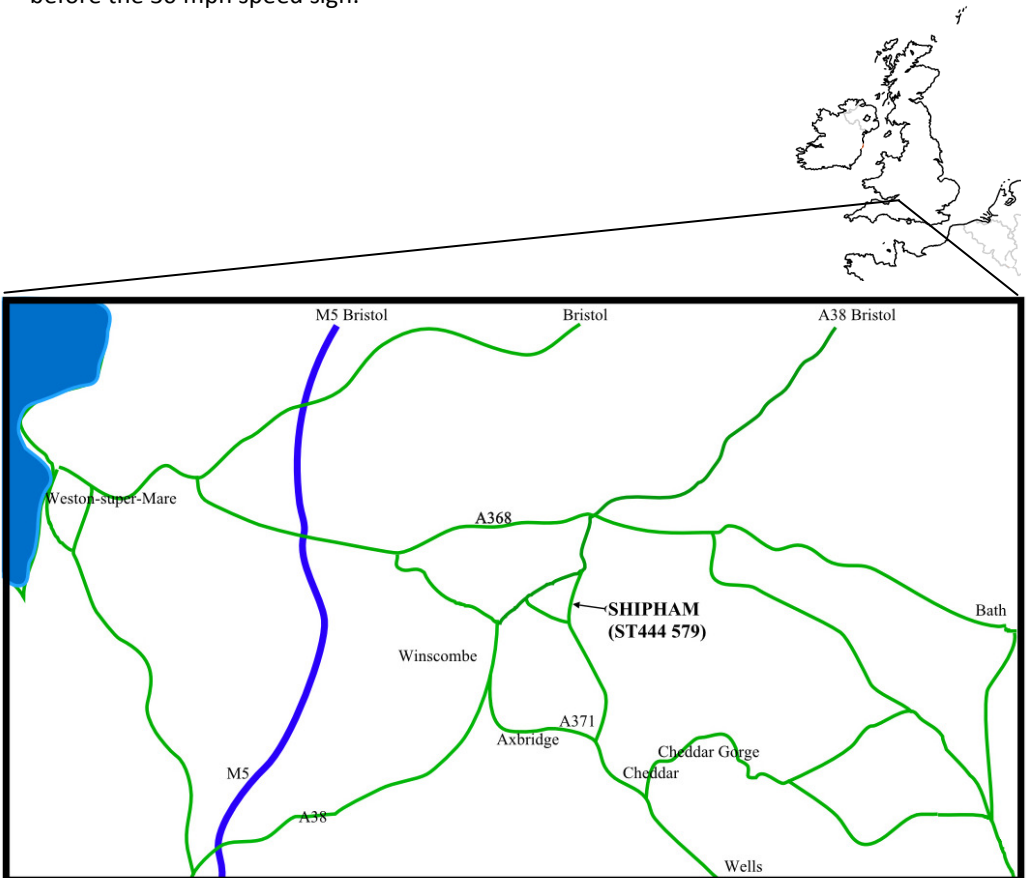
(Equipped with full disabled facilities).

Directions from North.

From Bristol take the A38 South. Arrive at Churchill Traffic Lights. Continue for 1 mile, at petrol station fork left to Shipham. The Hall is on the right after about 1/2 mile, immediately after the 30 mph speed sign.

Directions from South.

Take the A38 North towards Bristol. Continue after Sidcot Traffic Lights for almost 1 mile, turn off right for Shipham entering Broadway. After about 1/3 mile, in Shipham Village turn left at the cross roads back towards A38 for Bristol. The entrance for the Hall is next on left (about 300 yds), just after the Beech Road junction on the right and just before the 30 mph speed sign.
